5. For the reasons stated, the court finds that the ends of justice served by the granting of this continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant to a speedy trial.


WHEREFORE, the defendant prays that this matter be continued from the March 15, 2004 Criminal Term scheduled to be held in Charlotte, North Carolina.


